

Bathroom Procedures

Due to this year's efforts to social distance and to ensure the safety of our students and employees, we are establishing bathroom procedures for our Upper School students.

1. Each teacher will be given a lanyard with a bathroom pass on it.
2. Ideally, one student should be out of the classroom at a time. Teachers will use good judgement in an emergency and have an additional emergency lanyard.
3. Students who have permission and a pass will go to the nearest restroom.
4. There will be two hooks outside of each bathroom. Each student should hang his/her lanyard on the hook and then "take care of business." Flush the toilet / urinal. Wash his/her hands thoroughly. Immediately retrieve the lanyard and return to class without delay.
5. If both hooks already have a lanyard hanging outside the bathroom, the student should wait until another student exits.

Lunch Procedures

Lunch will look very different this school year. All Upper School students will eat by grade level until further notice. We encourage students to pack a lunch if possible. There will be grab and go, individually-wrapped food items for students to choose from should they eat from the prepared cafeteria food. **THERE WILL BE NO OUTSIDE FOOD ALLOWED! This includes delivery services such as delivery pizza, Uber Eats, GrubHub, and more. Parents and family members will not be allowed to drop off lunches.** This practice has always been against the rules, and will be strictly enforced for the safety of all students and CSAS employees.

MS Lunch will work on a three-day/ three-location rotation, practicing social distancing in each area. Grade levels will rotate each day, weather permitting.
For example: Monday - 6th in the Cafeteria; 7th in the stadium; 8th grade in classrooms

HS Lunch will work on a four-day/four-location rotation, practicing social distancing in each area. Grade levels will rotate each day, weather permitting.
For example: Monday - 9th in the Cafeteria; 10th in the stadium; 11th on the front steps/lawn; 12th in classrooms

No students will be allowed to eat in a teacher's room on days when they are to eat in a different location.

Unfortunately, seniors will not be allowed to eat off campus on Wednesdays until we receive word that it is acceptable to do so again.
